Rules for conduct of an annual Member's Photo Competition

- 1. An annual competition shall be held for the best photographs submitted by Members in that year. This is a fun event with no serious intent beyond sharing our joy of sailing with fellow members.
- 2. Only members of HOA may enter the competition. They may submit one photograph only per year.
- 3. Prizes, if any, will be announced at the opening of the competition. All valid entries will be displayed on the website and the best will be used for a HOA Calendar.
- 4. Photos must contain an image of at least one Hurley boat.
- 5. Photos must have been taken in the current year or previous year, by the submitting Member/Life Member or by an immediate relative spouse/partner; sibling; parent; child.
- 6. Photos remain the intellectual property of the photographer. However, in entering the competition, the photographer automatically grants HOA rights to use the photo in fulfilment of its aims and objectives, including the Newsletter, web site and calendar.
- 7. The competition will run from 15th October to 15th September each year.
- 8. Members/Life Members will submit entries in electronic form by e-mail to the webmaster at any time throughout the competition. The e-mail must contain the name of the photographer, relationship to the Member/Life Member if not taken by themselves, date of photograph and a brief description of the image depicted.
- 9. Photographs will be displayed on a dedicated web page and will be available for viewing throughout the year.
- 10. Members will be invited to vote by e-mail for their choice for best photo, between 15th September and 15th October each year.
- 11. Members are not allowed to vote for their own photograph
- 12. The competition results will be announced by e-mail by 31st October, by notification on the website and in the newsletter.
