I bought this boat in 2014 as a project and have sailed it along the South coast of Britain and the French coast of Normandy and Brittany during the summer months and spent the first seven winter months restoring it. The interior has been completely stripped out and all the woodwork replaced to a very high standard with solid hardwood. All new electrics and plumbing (toilet renewed last year). Exterior: New fuel tank and fuel lines, all through hull fittings renewed. New bearings on rudder, and new starter motor on engine.
 All lines let back to the cockpit for easy handling. This boat has been stored ashore for the 6 winter months by the last two owners and has never had osmosis. This is a well built boat in very good condition and sold fully equipped.
